

Do not expose lighting fixture to rain, dust or other environmental conditions prior to installation and insertion of photo control or shorting cap (if so equipped). Best results will be obtained if installed and maintained according to the following recommendations.

ATTENTION RECEIVING DEPARTMENT: Note actual fixture description of any shortage or noticeable damage on delivery receipt. File claim for common carrier (LTL) directly with carrier. Claims for concealed damage must be filed within 15 days of delivery. All damaged material, complete with original packing must be retained.


WIRING DIAGRAM

NOTE: Please **DO NOT** unscrew the photocell. Remove the backplate to access the driver compartment and unplug the photocell to disable it.



THREADED KNUCKLE INSTALLATION

1. Pull the wires through the top part of the knuckle mount and affix it to the luminaire with the screws provided (Fig. 1.1).
2. Align the rubber gasket to the knuckle mount. Then pull the wire through the hole of the bottom part of the knuckle mount (Fig. 1.2). Please be careful and do not pinch the wires.





THREADED KNUCKLE INSTALLATION

3. Connect both parts of the knuckle mount using the bolt provided (Fig. 1.3).
4. Complete wire connections in pole or junction box (Fig 1.4). Please ensure that the luminaire is wired in accordance with the National Electrical Code and applicable local codes and ordinances. Proper grounding is required to ensure personal safety.
5. Loosen the bolt and adjust the knuckle mount's angle as desired, then tighten the bolt to lock into place (Fig. 1.5).
6. Pass threads of knuckle mount through mounting surface and secure with lock nut (Fig. 1.6).









POLE MOUNT INSTALLATION

1. Remove the yoke mount that comes standard with the luminaire.
2. Install the connection bracket to the luminaire and pull the wires through the centre hole of the connection bracket (Fig. 2.1).
3. Attach the desired mount (slip fitter, multi mount, or pole mount) to the connection bracket using the bolt provided (Fig 2.2).
4. Complete wire connections in pole or junction box. Please ensure that the luminaire is wired in accordance with the National Electrical Code and applicable local codes and ordinances. Proper grounding is required to ensure personal safety.
5. Loosen the bolt and adjust the mount angle as desired and tighten the bolt to lock into place (Fig. 2.3).







YOKE MOUNT INSTALLATION

1. Drill holes in the wall/pole, ensuring they align with the yoke mount holes.
2. Insert expansion bolts (not provided) into the drilled holes.
3. Mount the fixture to the wall/pole and secure it in place (Fig. 3.2).
4. Adjust angle of the fixture by loosening the screws on the yoke mount. Tilt the fixture to the desired angle, then tighten the screws on the yoke mount.
5. Make the electrical connections according to the wiring diagram (Fig. 3.1).




